

Rothwell Baptist Church – revised building user guide from 21 July 2021

Background

Although Government COVID-19 restrictions have ended, there is still a high rate of Virus transmission and even though most people are vaccinated, there is still a potential for serious harm to individuals.

Therefore, the following rules apply to the use of the RBC building.

1. Do not enter the building if you have any COVID symptoms, are self-isolating or are waiting for the results of a COVID test.
2. If you use the NHS COVID-19 app, then you should check in to the building using the QR code on the front door and obey any message the app gives you regarding self-isolation.
3. Please respect other people's space and keep your distance from others as far as possible.
4. Remember to regularly wash your hands and use hand sanitiser when entering and leaving the building.
5. Avoid physical contact with people you do not usually live with
6. Face coverings must be worn while moving around the shared areas of the building such as the entrance hall, corridors, and toilets. Other face covering policies can be set by individual groups depending on their own risk assessments.
7. Only two people are allowed in the kitchen at any one time. Use face coverings when serving people and ensure utensils and surfaces are clean when you have finished.
8. Fire exits should be open during meetings to ensure good ventilation. Use of the fire exits to leave the building is recommended to avoid two-way traffic in the corridors.
